

BROWS & FACE

Preparation & Aftercare Information



Before treatment

- Avoid exfoliating at least 48 hours before your treatment.
- Avoid anti-ageing products that contain active ingredients for example: retinols, glycolic acid, salicylic acid etc, at least 7 days before your treatment, as these can sensitise your skin.
- If you are undergoing any topical or oral treatment for acne, you must inform SKB before your appointment.
- Avoid fake tan products on the face for 3 days before your appointment.

After treatment

- Avoid touching or rubbing the treatment area for the first 24 hours.
- Avoid anti-ageing products that contain active ingredients for example: retinols, glycolic acid, salicylic acid etc, for 3 days after your treatment.
- Fake tanning products can be used on the face 3 days after treatment. For tinted brows, apply a barrier to the hair and small area around the brows prior to tanning to prevent discolouration of your tint.
- Avoid strong sunlight, the use of sunbed, saunas, steam rooms and swimming pools for 48 hours after your treatment.
- If you have had a Brow Lamination or Henna Brows treatment, avoid getting your brows wet for 24 hours.
- If you have had a Henna Brows treatment, avoid oily products on and around the brows to help results last longer.
- Remember your brows will be darker and more defined immediately after your treatment. Any makeup applied is not permanent and tint will fade depending on your frequency of cleansing.
- Follow SKB's recommendations and avoid tweezing between appointments.
- To keep your brows well conditioned, it is recommended that SKB's Brow Nourish is used nightly or Nouveau Lashes' Lash & Brow Conditioning Serum is used morning and evening. These products can be purchased from SKB.
- You must inform SKB immediately should you experience any swelling, itchy rashes, bruising, skin grazing or cuts after your treatment so the correct advice on a procedure to follow is provided.
